San Jose, CA — [Tuesday August 26, 2025] — 2.2 billion dollars of ESSR funding was spent on high dosage tutoring with the majority of this investment occurring on the East Coast, Mid West and the South East. Post ESSR, states are now making their own investments in high dosage tutoring to accelerate student learning and support their public education/charter systems. As the High Dosage Tutoring movement begins to spread on the west coast, [Bay Area Tutoring Association](#) (BATA), in partnership with [Silicon Valley Education Foundation](#), [National Student Support Accelerator](#), and the [Santa Clara County Office of Education](#), will host the **Second Annual Silicon Valley High Dosage Tutoring Summit** on **October 10, 2025**, at the Santa Clara County Office of Education.

This year's summit will unite school district decision makers, intervention specialists, ELOP managers, subject matter experts, funders, technology companies, and community partners to learn more about high dosage tutoring as the most effective, research-backed strategy for accelerating student learning during the school day and through expanded learning opportunities.
